Read: Luke 2:1-7

Activity: Look at your Christmas decorations. What do they say? Choose something that reminds you of Jesus' birth and place that at the center of your decorations.

Why did they have to take this trip? *Think & Pray*: Mary, Joseph and baby Jesus were away from home on the first Christmas, but they were together as a family.
