#### **Galatians 6:1-10**



Watch out for yourselves so you won't be tempted too. <sup>2</sup> Carry each other's burdens and so you will fulfill the law of Christ. <sup>3</sup> If anyone thinks they are important when they aren't, they're fooling themselves. <sup>4</sup> Each person should test their own work and be happy with doing a good job and not compare themselves with others....A person will harvest what they plant.

#### **Luke 18:9-15**

Jesus told this parable: "Two people went up to the temple to pray. One was a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood and prayed about himself, 'God, I thank you that I'm not like everyone else-crooks, evildoers, adulterers-or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week. I give a tenth of everything I receive.' But the tax collector stood at a distance. He wouldn't even lift his eyes to look toward heaven. Rather, he struck his chest and said, 'God, show mercy to me, a sinner.' I tell you, this person went down to his home justified rather than the Pharisee. All who lift themselves up will be brought low, and those who make themselves low will be lifted up."
