

## From the Pastor's Perspective



1 Peter 1:15

Grow Groups are back...and better! After a year with three series of small groups, we are launching a new initiative of small groups. In line with our Love.Grow.Serve. vision, we are calling them Grow Groups.

Jesus calls His followers to grow in faith. Growing in faith is a key component of being a Christian. We are called for more, and Jesus doesn't want us to stay the way we are. He loves us the way we are, but He loves us too much to leave us that way. Instead, He calls us to grow in holiness, of mind, heart and life. As Christians, we can "get by" by attending worship and doing occasional devotions and prayers on our own. Does this describe your faith walk? If so, I say you need more! I am convinced that although we can be a Christian like this, we will not grow. To grow, we need more. We need grow groups. We need to be a part of small groups that challenge us, push us, and keep us going deeper.

You need to be a part of a grow group, to grow! The good news is that you have all kinds of possibilities and variety! Last year, each of the group series followed the Sunday messages, and each group followed the same outline. As we grow in Continued on page 2....

### Pastor's Perspective Cont'd

Christ, however, we each have different needs and are at different places in our faith journeys. That is why we need variety. We are planning on offering three series of grow groups each year: once in the fall (Oct.-Nov.), once in the winter (Feb.-March), and once in the summer (July-Aug.). Each series will offer groups focusing in three different areas:

Learn: (Bible) Groups will learn about the Bible and do Bible studies together. Topics could include introduction to the Bible, overview of the Bible, themes in Scripture, difficult teachings, and studies of biblical characters and books.

Live: (Life application) Groups will concentrate on living out their Christian faith in daily life. Topics could include spiritual disciplines, faith sharing, and discipleship.

reLate: (Specific issues) Groups will explore specific issues or topics that relate to the current needs and issues people are facing. People will learn more about the different aspects of the issue or topic as well as how their Christian faith informs their understanding about them.

Notice the variety! Not only that, no two grow groups will offer the same study. And, groups will be offered by different hosts, at different times, on different days. There will certainly be something that will fit for everyone.

This October, grow groups are being offered Sunday mornings (before and after worship), Monday mornings, Wednesday evenings, and Friday mornings. Some groups are starting early in October, others later. The Wednesday evening groups, for example, won't start until Oct. 24. Yet all groups will be finished before the holidays.

During the year, when small groups are not offered, we will have ECHO. Parents and children are asked to be a part of ECHO when it is held, and then also be a part of a grow group when they are offered. Yes, there will be a grow group for kids, too! Youth will stay with their Wednesday program all year, in either Confirmation or Youth Group.

You can sign up for a grow group on the church website under <u>foresthillsumc.net</u>, in the church lobby, or by calling the office. Invite someone to come with you. Offer to pick them up or tell them you will save them a seat. That person doesn't even have to be a part of our church. Invite a neighbor, friend, or family member.

#### KID'S CORNER

If you are not getting tired of the word 'discipleship' by now, you have not been paying enough attention! This is what we are all about as a church. The same is true of our Kid's ministries. If we are not setting out to make disciples, we are failing our call as a church! Moreover, there is a big difference between setting out to do something, and actually getting that thing done. Over the past year, our church leadership has stopped to take a good look at what is God's heart and intent for our church. After prayer and retreats and meetings and more prayer, we have concluded that our purpose and call is, you guessed it, discipleship!

We have also concluded that this is easier said than done. If we really want to make disciples out of our kids, we are going to have to involve their parents. Pastor Tad Thompson writes: "Parents have the greatest opportunity to influence their children for the Kingdom of God." He goes on to say that "the church's emphasis on attracting the unchurched through entertainment and child-centered programs has not only not helped, it has hurt." This indictment is simply another way of pointing out that in the noise of flashy kid's ministry, the main point, discipleship, can easily be lost.

Our new Wednesday night program, ECHO, combines kids with their parents, so the task of discipleship remains with parents where it should be. Yet we as a church can come alongside and provide resources, encouragement and other means of support.

That said, we also recognize the importance of grow groups in the discipleship process. Grow groups allow you to study a particular topic in the context of what amounts to a mini-church. This environment can be important to kids as well. That is why, throughout the year, parents and kids can enjoy a consistent variety in what could be termed the "Discipleship Cycle." We move together between seasons of ECHO and Grow groups. During ECHO, we ask that families stick together so parents and kids can be on the same page. During Grow groups, parents can join a group of their choice and we will have a separate group just for kids. However, we must be clear: While Grow groups are in session, parents are not off the hook! There is still work to be done in the lives of their children. The church cannot pretend to adequately take on all the duties that discipleship demands.

The good news is that we are in this together. The partnership between the church and parents can have a powerful effect on the lives of kids. We hope this unique layout can engage families in different ways, but most importantly, we want to adhere to our main goal: making disciples!


