Christmas is about God showing up and disrupting your plans. What plans of yours is God disrupting this year? What do you need to do to not miss what God is up to?

Discuss: How does Christmas make a difference in your life? What would it mean to live celebrating Christmas in the new year? Make your New Year's resolutions on Christmas! Activity: Do something unplanned this Christmas, or this week, that serves God by serving others.

Prayer: Pray for Jesus to disrupt your plans. Invite God to meddle in your life!
