

From the Pastor's Perspective

"The unfolding of your words gives light; even the simple become wise." -Psalm 119:130

In July we start our summer message series, "FAQs: Your Questions Answered with Biblical Facts." Our Sunday messages will address whatever you've been wondering about: those puzzling questions you have about the Bible, or how Christians ought to respond to something, or why God seems to do-or not do-certain things. After all, discipleship is about living our faith out in our daily lives, guided by the Holy Spirit and God's Word. All of us are frequently puzzled, "How do I live as a faithful disciple about this or that?" Therefore, this summer we'll try to address whatever it is you've been puzzled about! The Bible applies to ALL parts of our lives, so there is no issue or topic off limits! Simply email, call, or write to the church office about a topic, question, Bible passage or issue that you would like to hear more about. We'll do our best to preach during the summer on whatever you submit. So far topics include: July 5 (Pastor David preaching): Should the American flag be displayed in worship? July 12 (Cassi preaching): What is Zion? July 19 (Pastor Andrew preaching): Do we really need the Old Testament? July 26 (Pastor David preaching): Why does God allow suffering? Aug. 2 (Pastor David preaching): How did we get our Bible? We need more ideas after this: please submit yours!

July also brings us back into the church sanctuary! (We will continue to offer remote worship as well, but it will be a recording of live Sunday worship and not be available until Sundays at 2 p.m.) We have not worshiped in our building since March. Since then we have offered recorded worship on our church website in March and April, "drive-in" worship in May, and outdoor worship in June.

Pastor's Perspective Cont'd

Some are ready to move indoors, others not. Our reasons for moving indoors are that it is getting warm outside, the weather is unpredictable, our worship leaders are having to lead worship twice during the week (once to record and twice to lead live worship—outdoor worship is not conducive to recording), it is a bit of a hassle to set up and take down outdoors, and other churches have already started indoor worship safely. We realize that some are not able to gather in worship safely just yet. We truly lament our inability to gather together fully, and we commit to continue to offer the best quality remote worship recordings for at least the summer.

We do ask everyone attending to honor safety protocols, such as wearing face masks, avoiding shaking hands or touching others, and practice social distancing. We will use

only every other pew, have doors propped open and have stationary offering plates. The nursery and coffee shop will be closed, and we ask users of the bathroom to wash hands thoroughly and use the paper towel to shut off the faucet and open the doors.

We are also reducing our daily video devotionals to twice a week (Mondays and Fridays). Please continue to connect with your "Connection Circles," especially if folks in your circle cannot attend worship in person.

Even with all these precautions, it will be good to gather as possible. We so appreciate your understanding, patience, and continued generosity during this seemingly endless time of precaution and distancing. God's people are resilient, for we have a source of strength and endurance that comes from God's Spirit within. More then this, God's people "shine" during times of difficulty, and we are a beacon of light and hope to others, bearing witness to our inner hope and peace.

Our theme verse for July is Psalm 119:130, "The unfolding of your words gives light; even the simple become wise." As we pursue in person worship asking FAQs of faith, may God's light make us wise!
