Welcome to Pastor Cassi!

We are so excited to celebrate that this month Cassi Betker has been approved as a Licensed Local Pastor and has been appointed to Forest Hills Church quarter-time as our Youth Pastor!

Cassi has felt God's calling on her life for many years to work in God's Church and recently more focused in youth ministry. She has volunteered in our church over the years in many capacities. At Red Rock Bible Camp, she has led the youth camp for 18 years as Dean of Women. Four years ago Cassi interviewed for the quarter-time position as youth leader at our church, and we eagerly hired her. She felt drawn to work more hours at our church and so added the half-time position as Director of Office Administration. A year ago, during the pandemic, she added five hours per week as our Director of Visual Media. Cassi wears many hats!

At Annual Conference in 2019 Cassi felt God nudging her to pursue licensing as a Local Pastor. This would provide affirmation and credentialing for her calling in youth ministry. She sought out confirmation and then pursued candidacy with our Conference. A key step was our church unanimously recommending her for candidacy at Charge Conference the fall of 2019. After two years of discerning, mentoring, writing, assessments and interviews, Cassi was approved in July of 2021 as a Licensed Local Pastor of the Minnesota Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church! Congratulations, Cassi: we celebrate with you!

Our Church Ministry Management Team (CMMT), in its Staff-Parish role, requested that Cassi be appointed to Forest Hills Church as our quarter-time Youth Pastor. Bishop David Bard approved her appointment in July and the Rev. Susan Nienaber (our District Superintendent) officially installed her at Forest Hills starting August 1, 2021.

So, as a church, we not only celebrate Cassi's licensing, we also welcome her in her new title as "Pastor Cassi!"

On one hand, not much has changed. Cassi will continue doing the same 35-hours per week multiple positions for our church.

Her compensation will remain the same. And Cassi has told us that for now she understands her calling is to continue in these roles at Forest Hills Church. We are so glad to hear that!

On the other hand, there are some changes. We will now be calling her "Pastor Cassi." She will be able to administer the sacraments (The Lord's Supper and baptism) at Forest Hills Church. She will have to go to (remote) Licensing School next year and then complete her Course of Study (mostly remote) after that.

Although her relationship with our church has not really changed, her relationship with the Annual Conference has. As a Licensed Local Pastor, Cassi is eligible to serve in any appointment (youth ministry or otherwise) anywhere in the Minnesota Annual Conference. Unlike "Ordained Elders" (such as Pastor David) who serve "in itineracy" (they must go and serve however, wherever and whenever the Bishop appoints), Licensed Local Pastors serve at the request of churches and the Bishop. Ordained Elders are "tenured" with the Conference and are therefore guaranteed an appointment, whereas Licensed Local Pastors are appointed only "as requested."


For now Pastor Cassi has felt her calling is to continue on in her roles at Forest Hills Church. She still feels called to pursue Youth Ministry and will be focusing her Licensing School and

Course of Study in that area. At some point she may discern a calling to serve in some other way or at some other church. But for now, we affirm that God has placed her here among us as a gift, and we vow to serve the youth and the next generations for Jesus along side her.

Missionary Dinner and Concert

Our church is so excited to welcome onsite, for the first time in three years, the missionaries that we support regularly as a church. Tim and Kristina Lewis (alias names...to learn their real names—and see their picture—check out the materials at our church's Welcome Center) and their four children (ages 8-14) are all coming to Forest Hills on Wednesday, August 4 to host an evening concert:



- 5 p.m. Meet and Greet
- 6 p.m. Dinner (in our newly air-conditioned fellowship hall!)
- 7 p.m. Concert (in the sanctuary)

The family serves in central Asia, in a country that only recently lifted its ban on Christianity. It still is illegal, however, to convert people to the Christian faith, and so our missionaries work behind the scenes. Tim had been publicly working as a professor of history but during the pandemic switched to working full-time on the Bible Project to bring the Bible in the local language through video media. Much of their ministry is relationship-based, and they host small groups and events in their home. Through hospitality and meals, discussion leads to talk about the message of Jesus.

Their missions work includes providing education and discipleship among the unreached in central Asia. They work through World Venture, and they have been working in Cental Asia for 12 years. Their desire is to see God establish and grow His church in central Asia, by changing how people see Jesus Christ. Their long term mission is to see Central Asian families transformed by Christ into having a biblical worldview that changes not only their own lives, but society as well.

Support them! Most importantly, pray for them regularly. Pray for the work of the Gospel to spread through their ministry.

Also support them financially. Our church takes up an annual offering for them, but we can receive financial support at any time (give in the offering plate, online, or electronically, designated "Missionaries"). We are taking up an offering right now so we can present it to them when they come on August 4. A more consistent way of supporting them financially is to "sponsor" them on a monthly basis. Two years ago our church sent hand-made quilts for each of them. Then, when they moved into their new home, we paid for the beds, bedding and fridge. Our special offering last year paid for their long -term green cards. This year, we get to support them with personal greetings and physical hugs! Don't miss the concert, and give generously to support them!
