### *From the Pastor*

The branches just outside of my office window have turned their leaves from green to a brilliant orange. Soon they will be standing stark and bare. Fall always brings with it changes, many of which we cannot control: our children reach another grade, our houses need updating, businesses are starting up/shutting down, our yards continue to balk at being maintained.

Time marches on and we are forced to accompany. Yet, even in the progression of the coming year, there are aspects that we can control. As humans, God has given us the wonderful ability to plan. We can assess what we have, dream about what we would like and make plans to get us there. As a church, we want to serve the Lord. Our expressed goal is to “make disciples who make disciples.” The “how” of accomplishing this task is always up for discussion, but, over the years, we have landed on a few principles that define who Forest Hills is as a church.

One of our answers to the “how” question is to be a congregation that stays active! In this month alone we are volunteering at St. Andrew’s homeless shelter, supporting MN Adult and Teen Challenge and hosting a craft sale. That is a busy schedule! As this is one of our defining values, we wanted to make the efforts of our doing a bit easier through the construction of an outdoor pavilion. Having such a space will greatly support who we are. It would function as an extension of our ministry as well as help communicate to the surrounding community who Forest Hills Church is and what we are all about.

“Building a Bigger Tent” is our slogan for this project, but make no mistake, we are talking about a permanent structure out in the field beyond our parking lot. We are talking about a significant investment. We are talking about expanding our ability to host events in an inviting and useful way.

The overall cost for the pavilion (\$125,000) has been broken down into three sub-totals:

- 30’ x 60’ pavilion (\$29,000) - Concrete flooring (\$16,000)
- Attached garage space (\$80,000)

## Youth at Forest Hills

This month we are taking Pastor Andrew's sermon series on "Building in Faith" and looking at it from a different perspective. We will be taking the next 3 weeks and asking "Why Church?" If you are aware of the statistics that have gone around the last few years, you are probably as troubled by the Church drop-out rate as we are. Students are finding that the local body of believers is often at odds with their rapidly shifting culture. Once they begin to experience life outside the Christian "bubble" of their childhood, they begin to realize that the world is a diverse and highly relational place. This section of curriculum tackles two issues for students: The relational realities of their world which is in seeming conflict with the Church and the purpose of the Church community in their lives. The hope that the scriptures found in these lessons will bring about a counter-cultural revolution in these students. The teachings of Jesus were revolutionary in his own day and carry the same weight in these uncertain times. And, let's face it, loving God with our whole being and loving others well is stinking hard. We believe students are up for the challenge and the Church should be both the launching pad and home base for those desiring to live a flourishing life in Christ.

I'm also excited to welcome Zach H. He has volunteered to be an adult volunteer at Youth Group. This is such a blessing for myself and the teens.
