Our Grow Groups have been a success! I have heard many comments about "The Chosen" and how the series has enhanced the New Testament. The conversations and scenes in the film, though not directly from scripture, help provide a backdrop to the Gospel accounts.

The hope is that as we watch these episodes, they will inspire and encourage you to dig into the Bible with fresh eyes. We never want to rely on a filmmaker or a production company to provide us with spiritual food, so be sure to both watch AND read! "The Chosen" sermon series will take us through the month of October. The leaves are starting to turn and there is a crispness to the air which means our stewardship season is coming! How do you intend on giving to the church and other ministries? Stewardship involves a bit of planning as well as commitment. giving card for the coming year so we can sow generously into the fields that God has prepared! This month we bid farewell to our Worship Director Lars Carlson. Lars and his wife Chloe have been a wonderful addition to the music ministry at Forest Hills. Lars brings to the stage an immense amount of talent, but more importantly, he functions out of love for Jesus and His church. We have enjoyed worshipping the Lord with Lars, and we wish him all the best as he moves on to serve elsewhere. Lar's last service at Forest Hills will be Oct. 15. We will serve some treats before service begins that morning for any who would like to come and say goodbye to the Carlsons.

On Sunday Oct. 1 st we convened a special church conference and voted on whether or not Forest Hills should sell the church parsonage. After an informational meeting and some discussion the week before, the proposition passed in a 40-5 vote. Certainly, this is not a decision made lightly. There are pros and cons to either option, which is why we refer these important decisions to such a vote.

Forest Hills Church owns the parsonage outright and, in the near future, steps will be taken to put the house on the market in the hopes of receiving a good offer. Since all United Methodist buildings and property are owned by the Minnesota Conference, proceeds from the sale have certain restrictions. While the money cannot pay for operational costs or general budget needs, it can go toward capital needs and building maintenance as well as paying off the mortgage on our actual church building.
